

UHI RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING: *Vaccinations*

1. UHI recommends that you **read** the vaccine package inserts before you subject yourselves or your children to oral, injectable, or nasal-spray vaccines. It is imperative that doctors provide you the vaccine package inserts. If it is not offered, ask. Make sure the package inserts are offered in a readable form. (Right now, the inserts are on tissue-like paper with minute printing. In order to read them, they must be enlarged.)
2. UHI alerts parents: **understand** that vaccine manufacturers have no liability whatsoever when a child has a vaccine reaction, from a mild reaction to death. (According to court precedent, if a vaccine damages you or your child in a way described as *possible* in the package inserts, the manufacturer is free of liability.)
3. UHI reminds parents that there is no mandate on vaccinations in the United States of America. It is your **constitutional right** to decline to be vaccinated. Various types of exemptions are allowed in every state. (Furthermore, an exemption permits a child to enter school without having been vaccinated.)
